

Go to <https://mail.cableracer.com> Login with your email address and email password. Click on Settings then Spam Settings. Then Change Threshold Level to High or Very High. Change Spam Folder to Spam. You can manually add Allowed and Blocked senders here. Or see next picture to add from the mailbox view.


